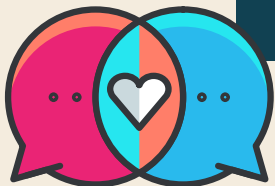


A Couple for the Road Bonaire Travel Tips

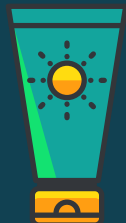
Bonaire is a part of the Leeward Antilles, where most residents speak four or more languages!

Suntan and Snorkel

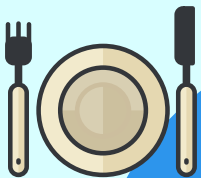
Bonaire is best known for its unbeatable snorkeling and diving! With year-round sun and warm waters it's a paradise in every sense of the word!

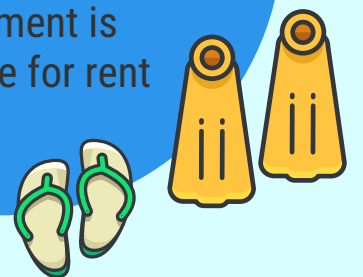
